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Arizona Employment Increased by 59,800 Jobs Since November 2023 Arizona Unemployment Increased to 3.7%

The Arizona seasonally adjusted (SA) unemployment rate increased to 3.7% in November 2024 from 3.6% in October 2024. The U.S. SA unemployment rate increased to 4.2% in November 2024 from 4.1% in October 2024.

Month over month, Arizona's SA labor force decreased by 6,311 individuals, or 0.2%. Year over year, the SA labor force increased by 29,276 individuals, or 0.8%.

Month over month, Arizona not-seasonally adjusted (NSA) total nonfarm employment increased by 31,600 jobs. Year over year, NSA total nonfarm employment increased by 59,800 jobs, or 1.8%. Arizona SA total nonfarm employment increased by 4,100 individuals, or 0.1%, month over month.

Month Over Month

Arizona NSA nonfarm employment increased by 31,600 jobs in November. Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), NSA nonfarm employment gained 28,800 jobs on average in November. The private sector recorded a gain of 28,300 jobs in November, led by gains in Trade, Transportation & Utilities (18,200 jobs) and Health Care and Social Assistance (4,500 jobs). Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), private sector employment averaged a gain of 27,200 jobs in November. The government sector recorded a gain of 3,300 jobs in November, more than the pre-pandemic (2010-2019) average gain of 1,600 jobs. Employment gains in the government sector occurred primarily within Local Government (2,700 jobs).

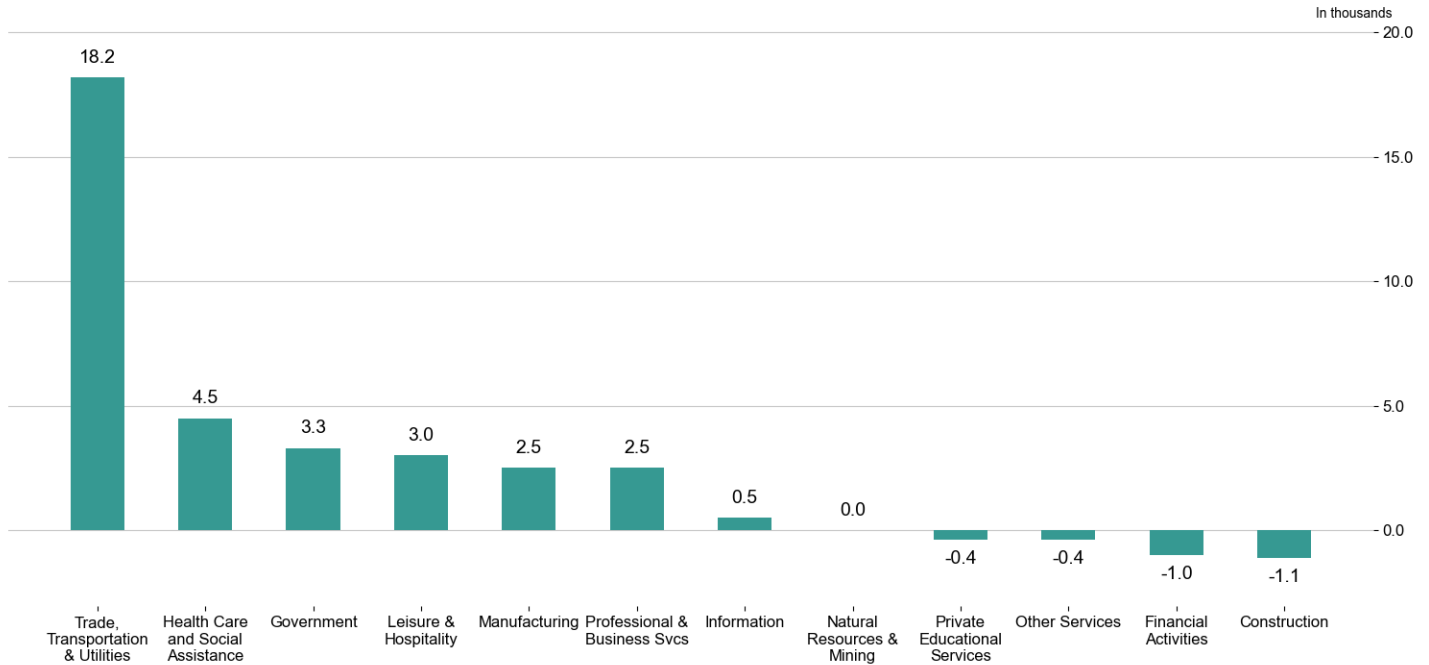

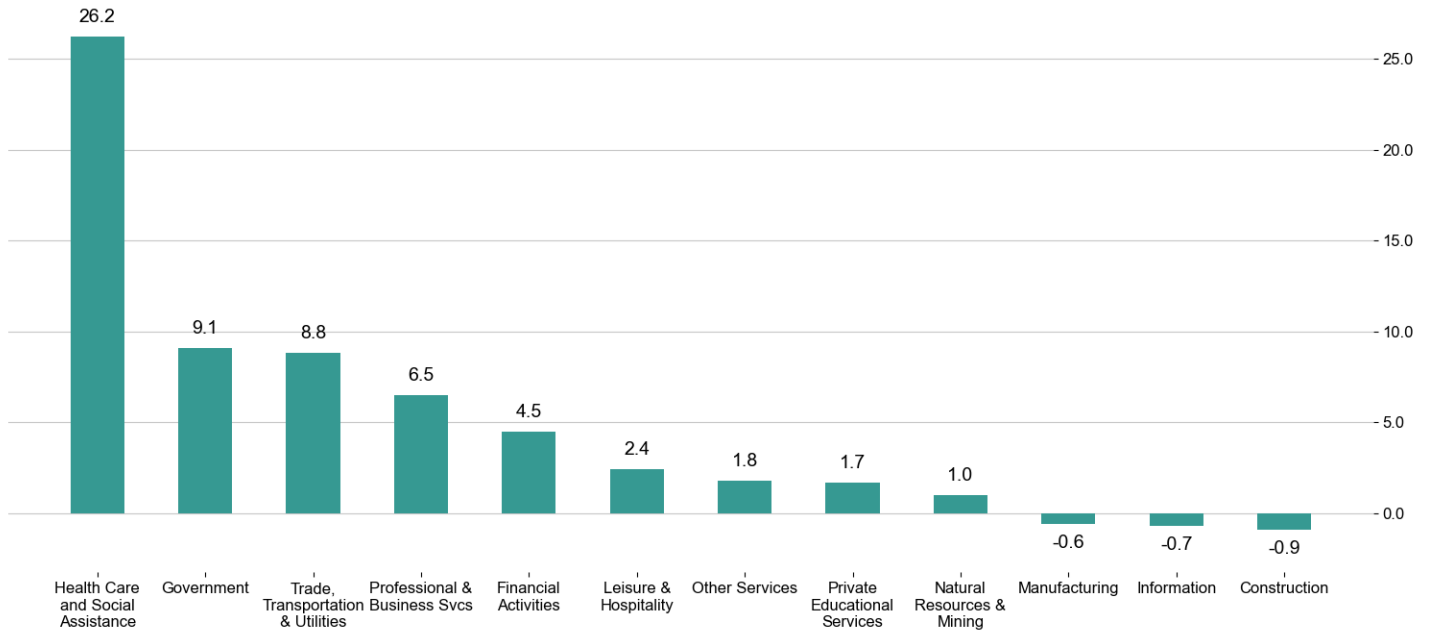

Arizona NSA Year-Over-Year Employment Gain/Loss by Sector

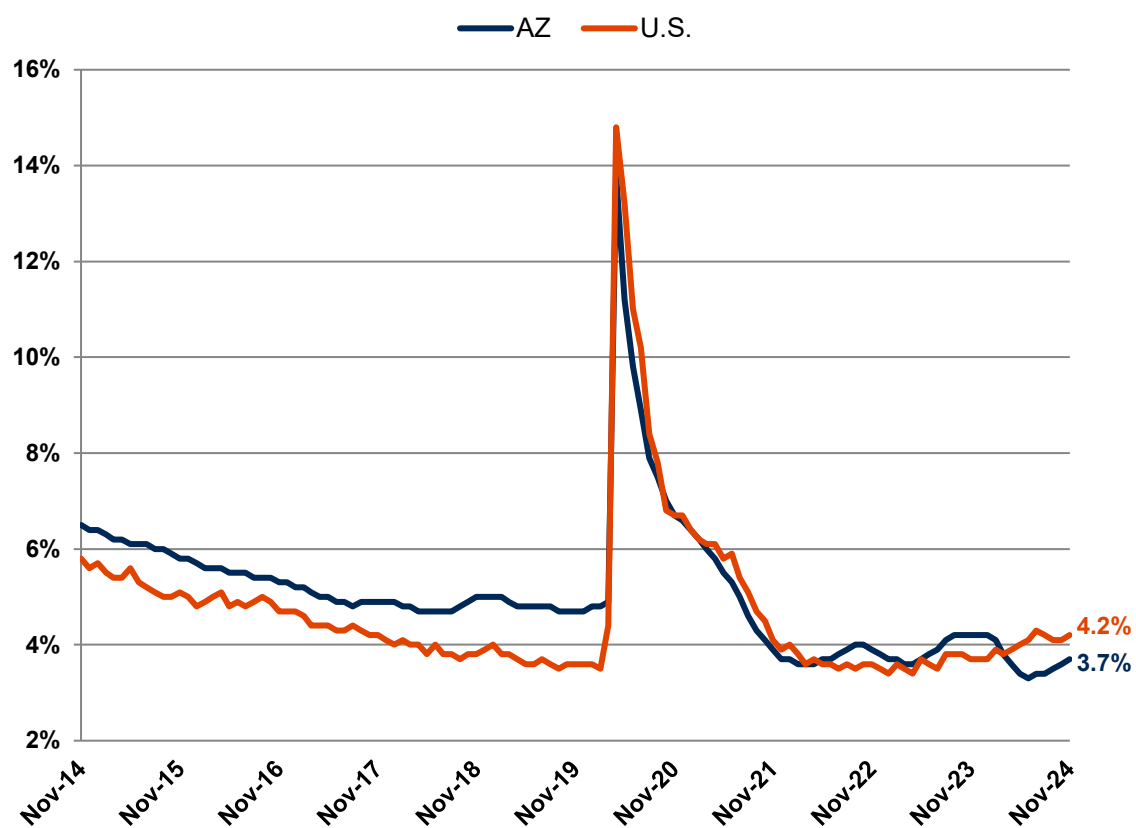

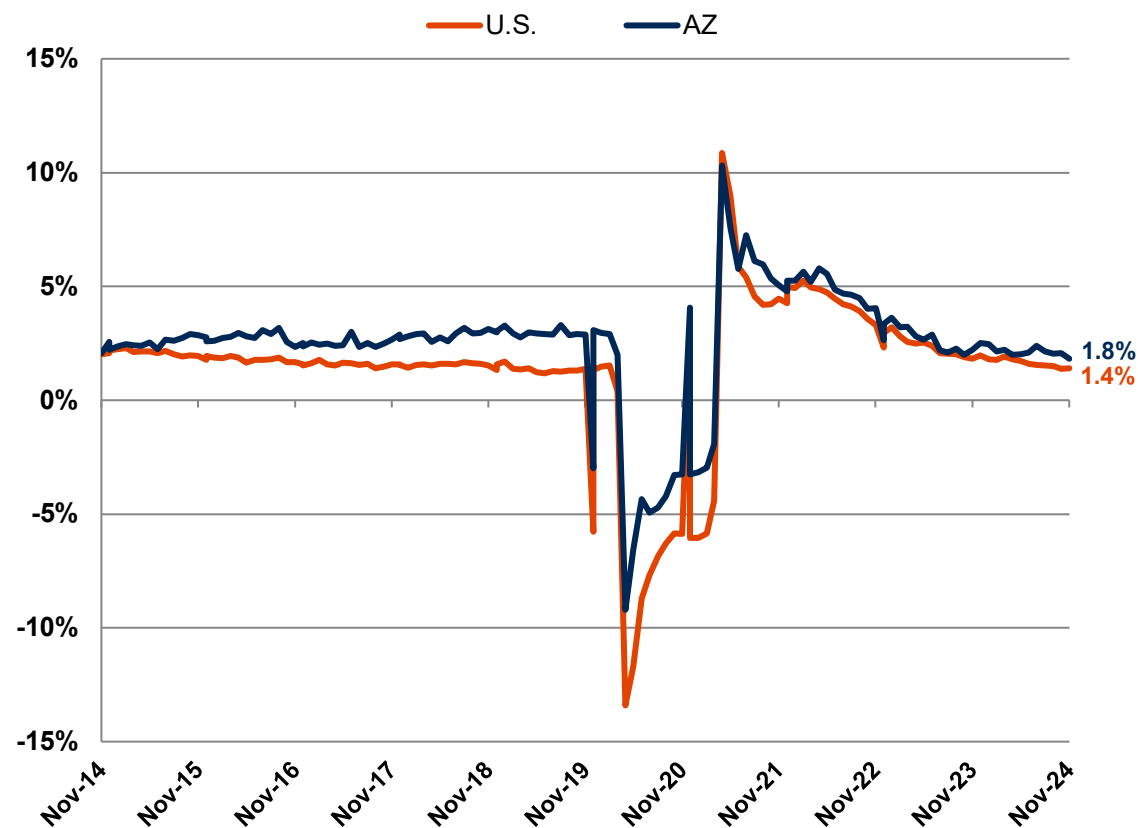

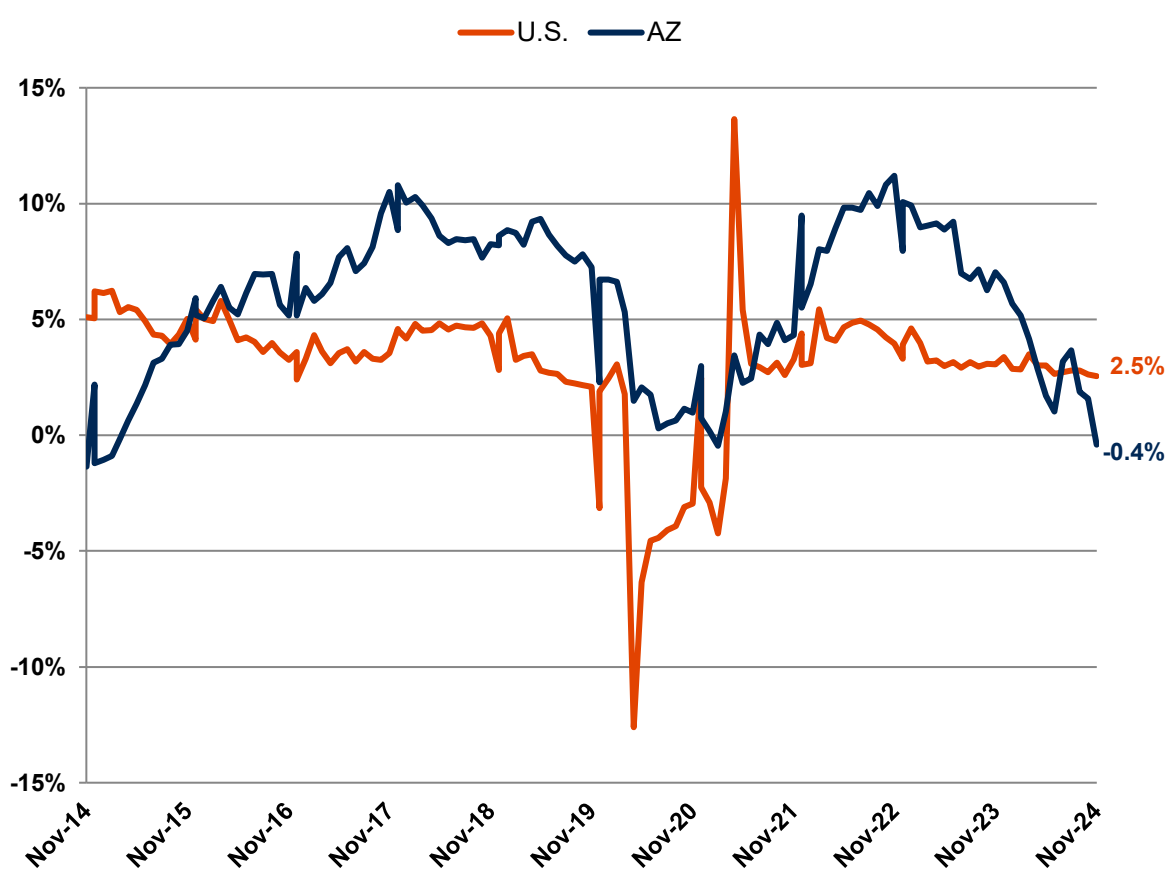
Arizona & U.S. Unemployment Rate
Seasonally Adjusted



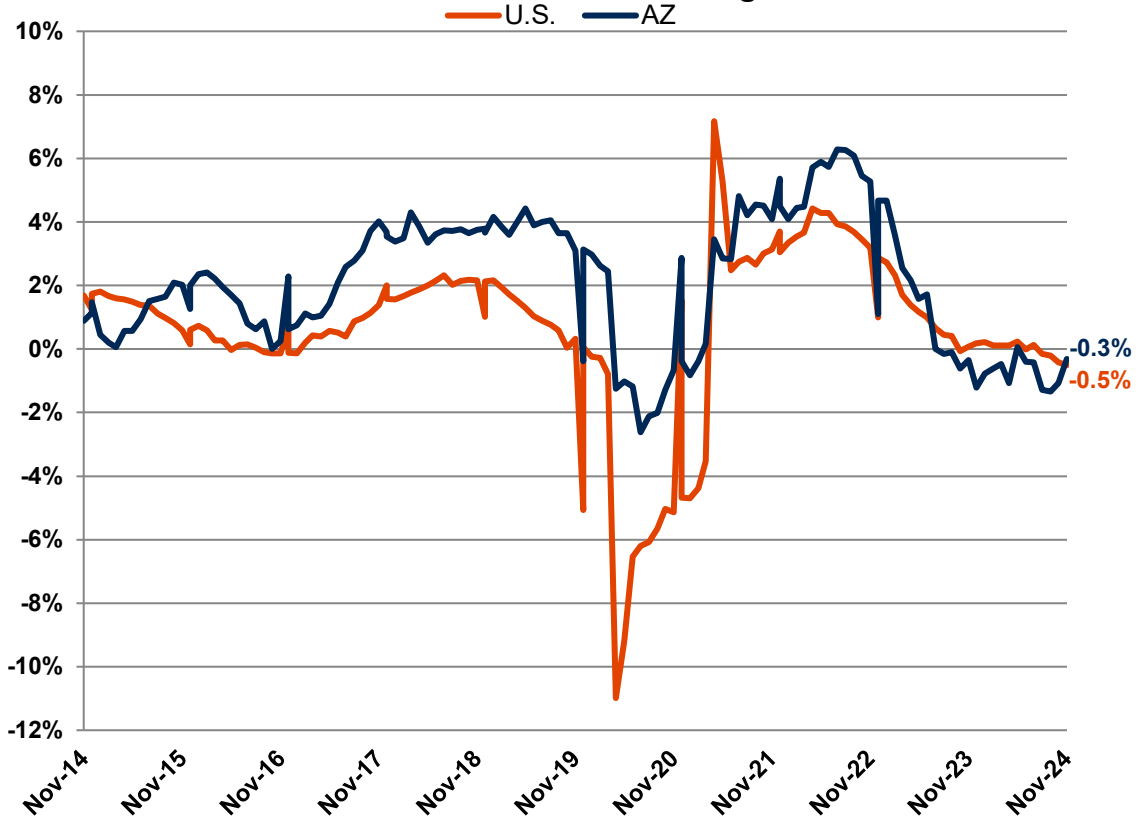
Arizona & U.S. Nonfarm Employment

Year-to-Year Percent Change



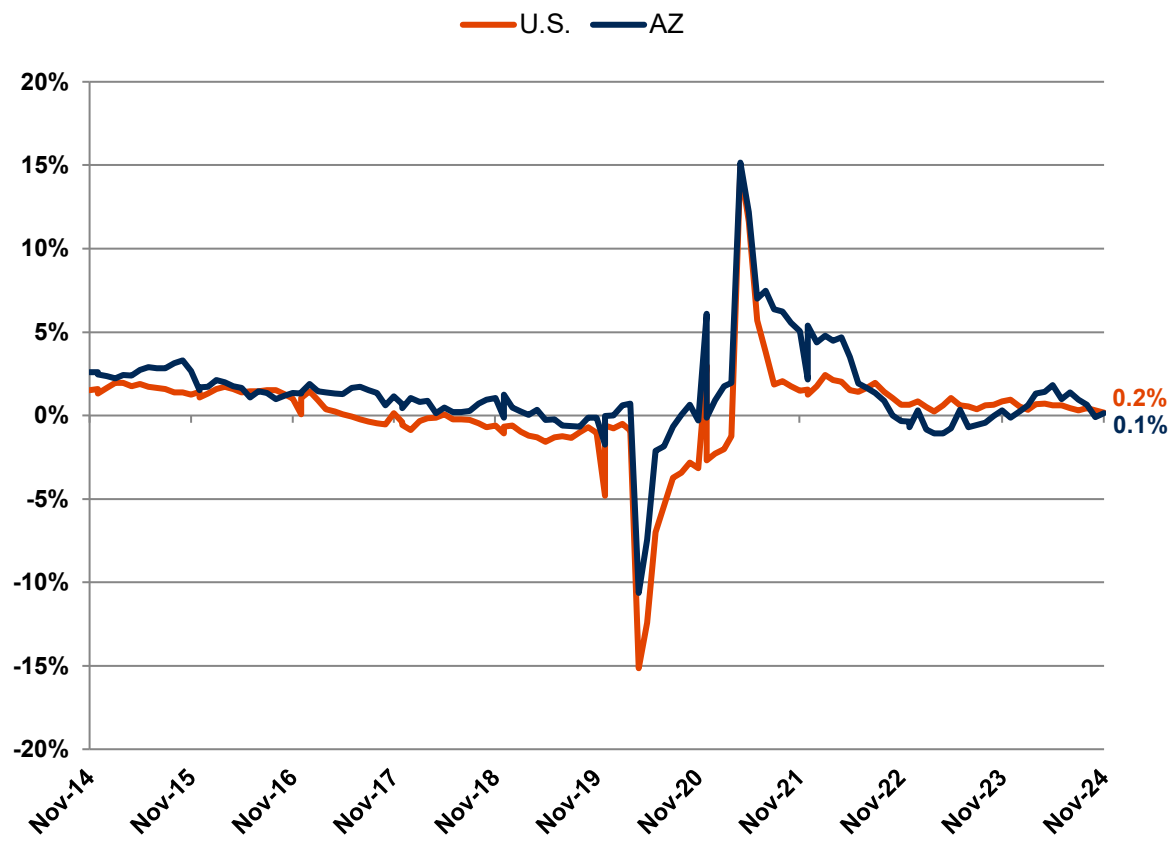
Arizona & U.S. Manufacturing Employment
Year-to-Year Percent Change



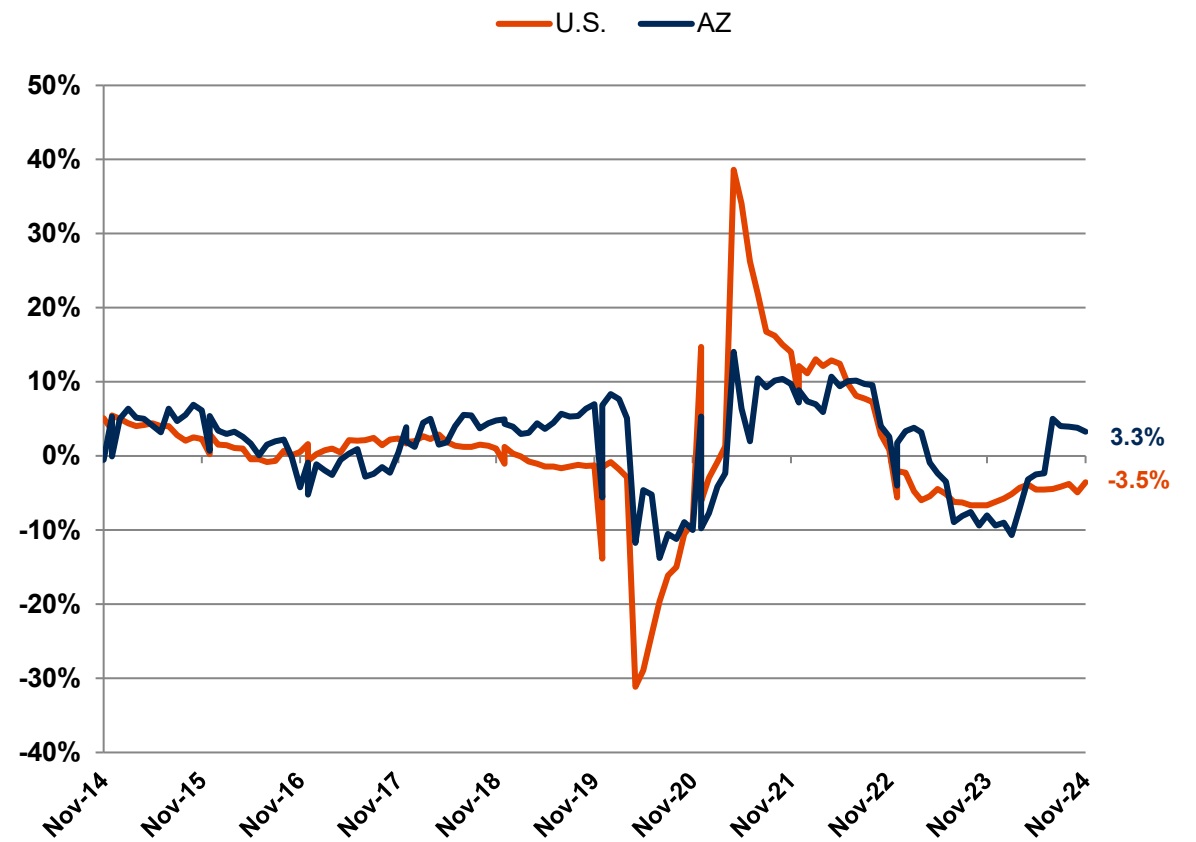

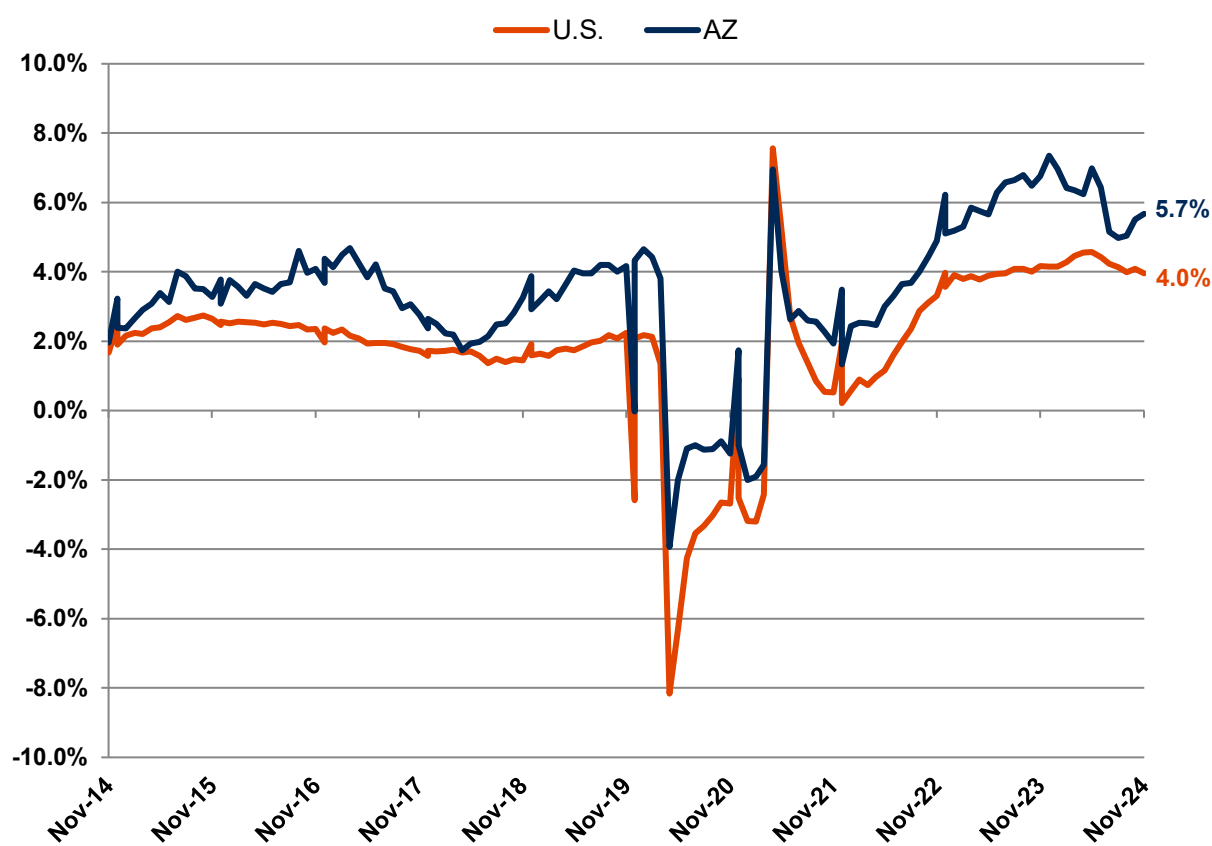
Arizona & U.S. Retail Trade
Year-to-Year Percent Change



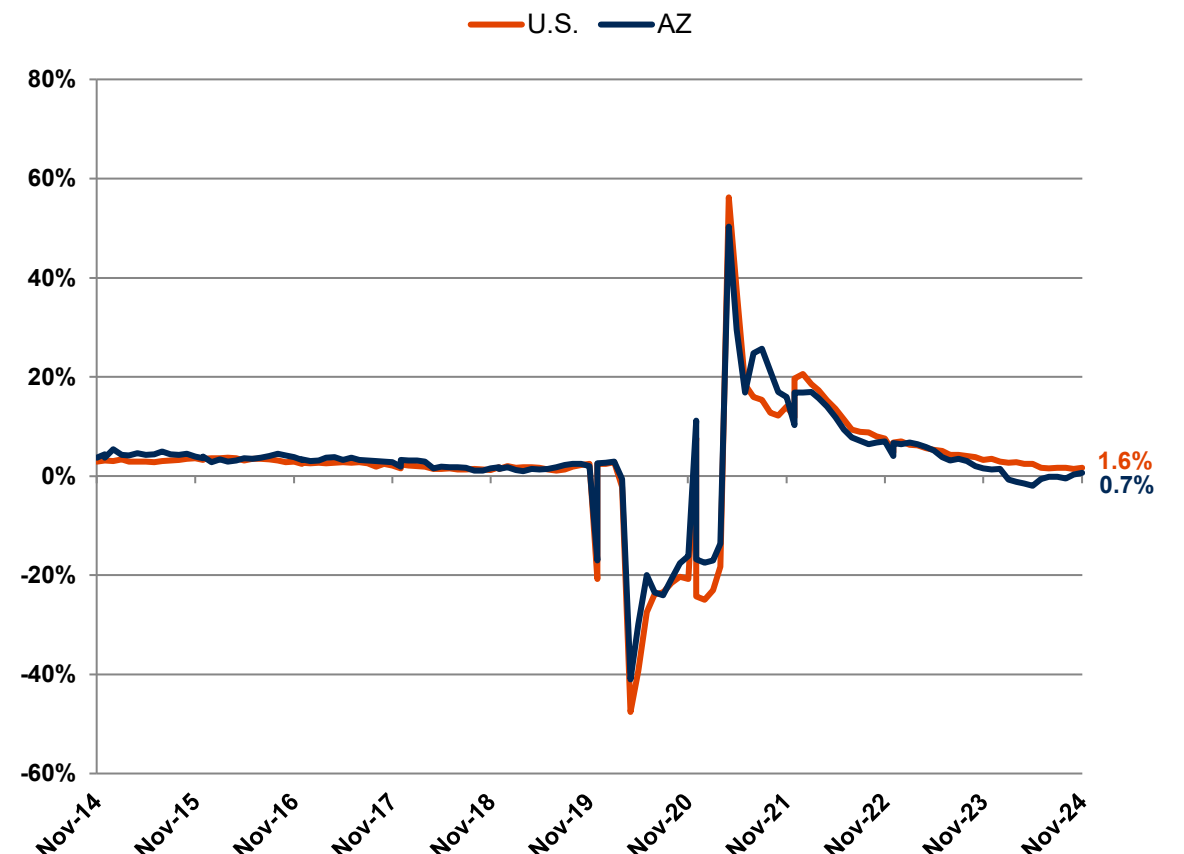
Arizona & U.S. Employment Services
