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Arizona Employment Increased by 34,300 Jobs Since July 2024 Arizona Unemployment Remained at 4.1%

The Arizona seasonally adjusted (SA) unemployment rate remained at 4.1% in July 2025 from June 2025. The U.S. unemployment rate increased to 4.2% in July 2025 from 4.1% in June 2025.

Month over month, Arizona's SA labor force increased by 4,729 individuals, or 0.1%. Year over year, the SA labor force increased by 50,986 individuals, or 1.4%.

Month over month, Arizona not-seasonally adjusted (NSA) total nonfarm employment decreased by 18,600 jobs. Year over year, NSA total nonfarm employment increased by 34,300 jobs, or 1.1%. Arizona SA total nonfarm employment decreased by -4,900 individuals, or -0.2%, month over month.

Month Over Month

Arizona NSA nonfarm employment decreased by 18,600 jobs in July. Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), NSA nonfarm employment lost 19,900 jobs on average in July. The private sector recorded a loss of 13,400 jobs in July, led by losses in Leisure & Hospitality (-7,900 jobs) and Trade, Transportation & Utilities (-4,200 jobs). Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), private sector employment averaged a loss of 7,000 jobs in July. The government sector recorded a loss of 5,200 jobs in July, less than the pre-pandemic (2010-2019) average loss of 12,900 jobs. Employment losses in the government sector occurred primarily within Local Government Education (-3,400 jobs).

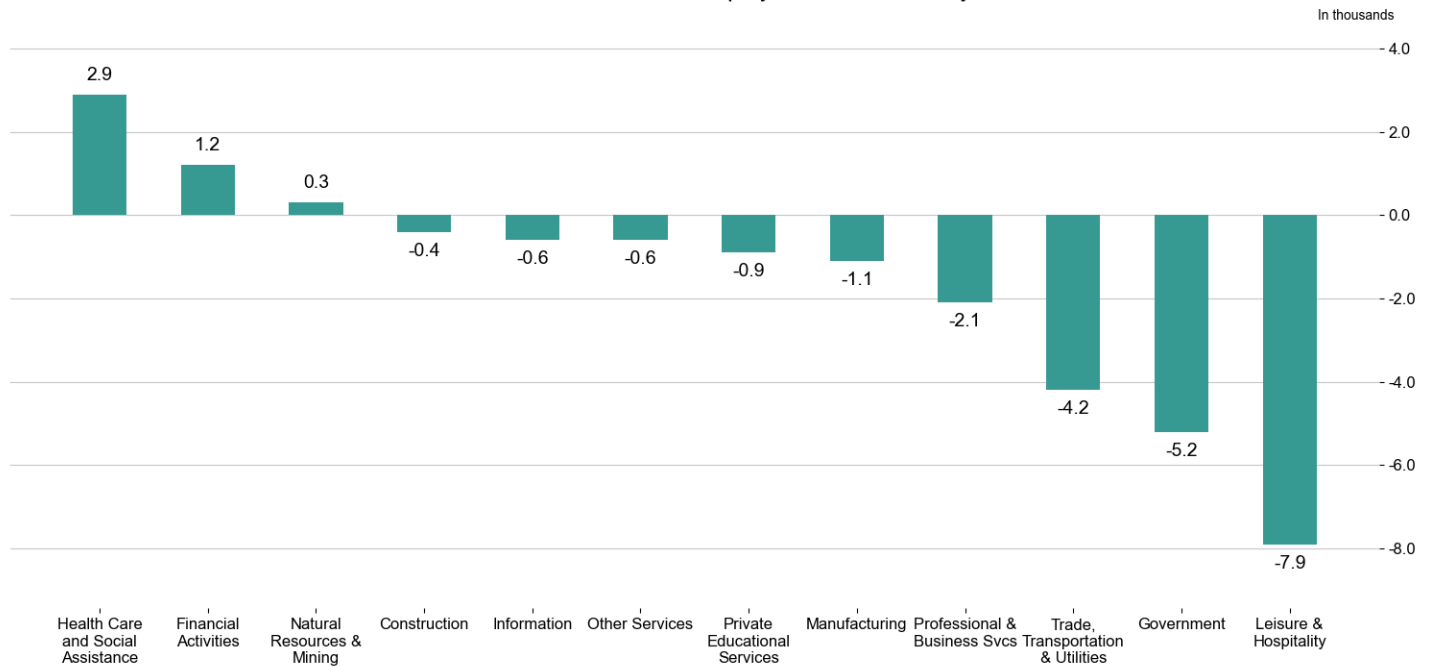

Arizona NSA nonfarm employment increased by 34,300 jobs or 1.1% in July year over year. Private sector employment increased by 37,200 jobs year over year, while government employment decreased by 2,900 jobs year over year.

Arizona NSA Year-Over-Year Employment Gain/Loss by Sector

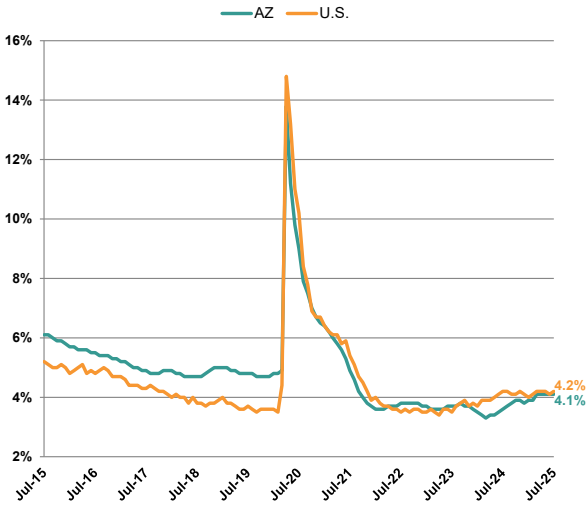

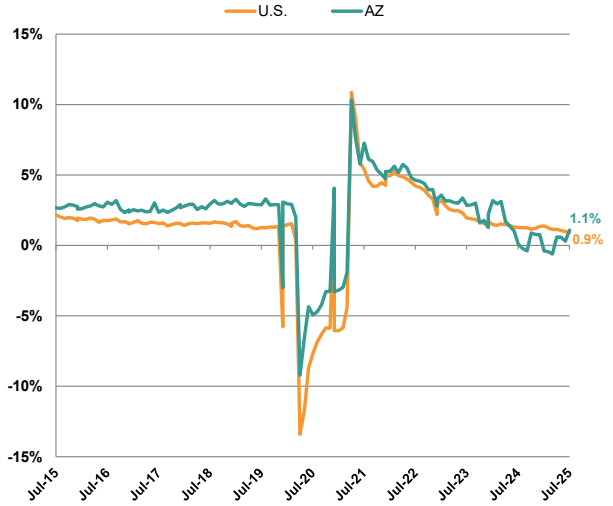

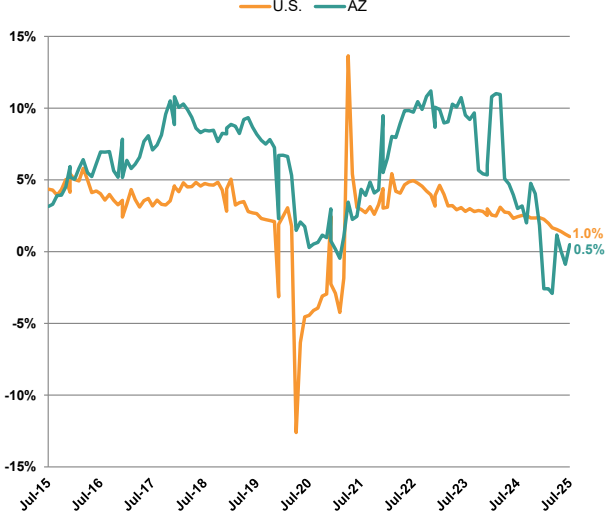
Arizona & U.S. Unemployment Rate
Seasonally Adjusted



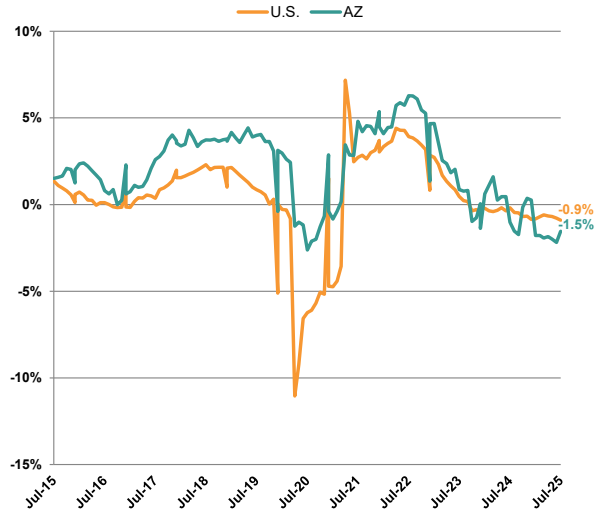
Arizona & U.S. Nonfarm Employment

Year-to-Year Percent Change



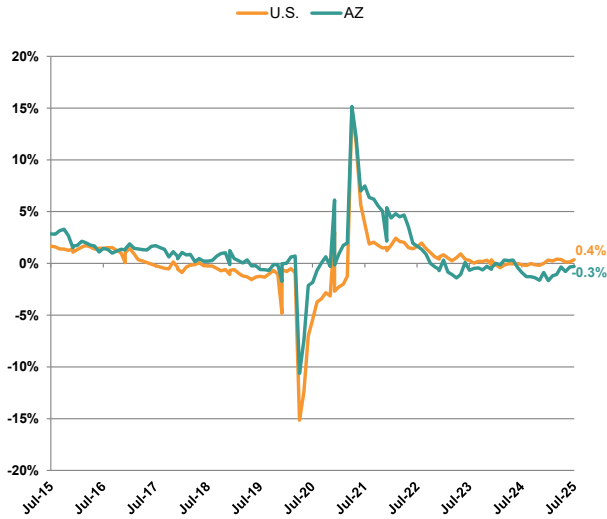
Arizona & U.S. Manufacturing Employment
Year-to-Year Percent Change



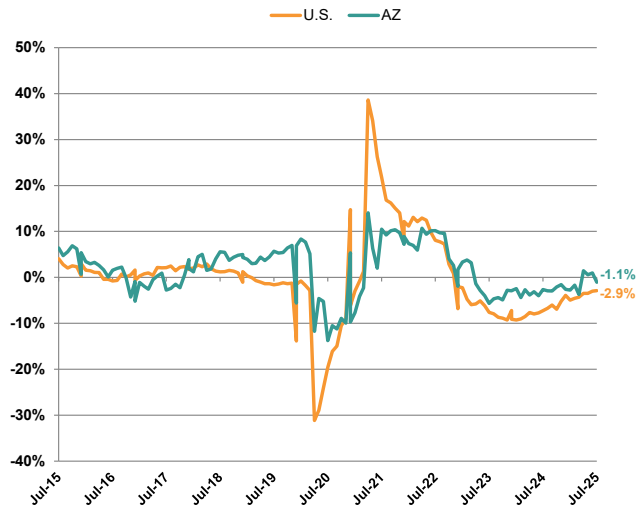

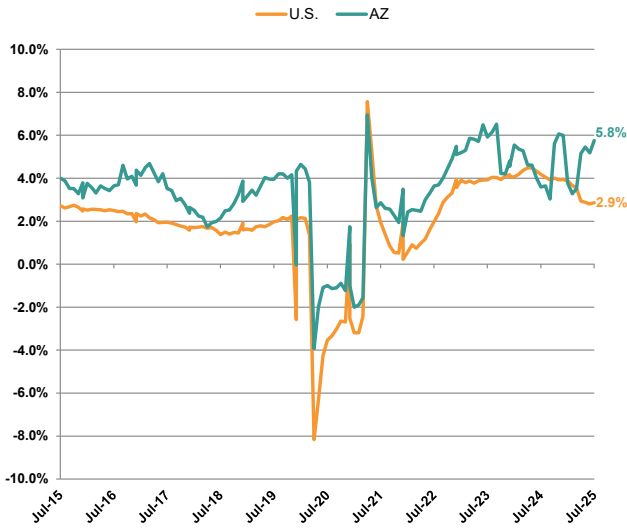
Arizona & U.S. Retail Trade
Year-to-Year Percent Change



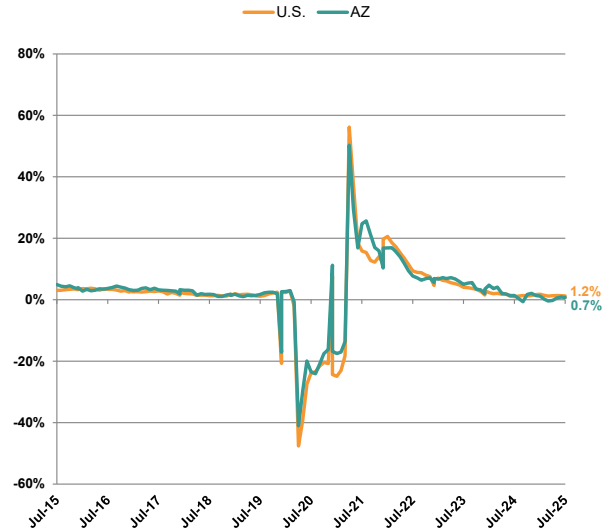
Arizona & U.S. Employment Services
