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Arizona Employment Increased by 38,500 Jobs Since August 2024 Arizona Unemployment Remained at 4.1%

The Arizona seasonally adjusted (SA) unemployment rate remained at 4.1% in August 2025 from July 2025. The U.S. SA unemployment rate increased to 4.3% in August 2025 from 4.2% in July 2025.

Month over month, Arizona's SA labor force increased by 3,894 individuals, or 0.1%. Year over year, the SA labor force increased by 50,234 individuals, or 1.3%.

Month over month, Arizona not-seasonally adjusted (NSA) total nonfarm employment increased by 42,100 jobs. Year over year, NSA total nonfarm employment increased by 38,500 jobs, or 1.2%. Arizona SA total nonfarm employment gained 700 individuals, or 0.0%, month over month.

Arizona NSA nonfarm employment increased by 42,100 jobs in August. Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), NSA nonfarm employment gained 54,000 jobs on average in August. The private sector recorded a gain of 18,700 jobs in August, led by gains in Health Care and Social Assistance (5,300 jobs) and Professional & Business Services (4,700 jobs). Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), private sector employment averaged a gain of 18,400 jobs in August. The government sector recorded a gain of 23,400 jobs in August, less than the pre-pandemic (2010-2019) average gain of 35,600 jobs. Employment gains in the government sector occurred primarily within Local Government Education (26,200 jobs).

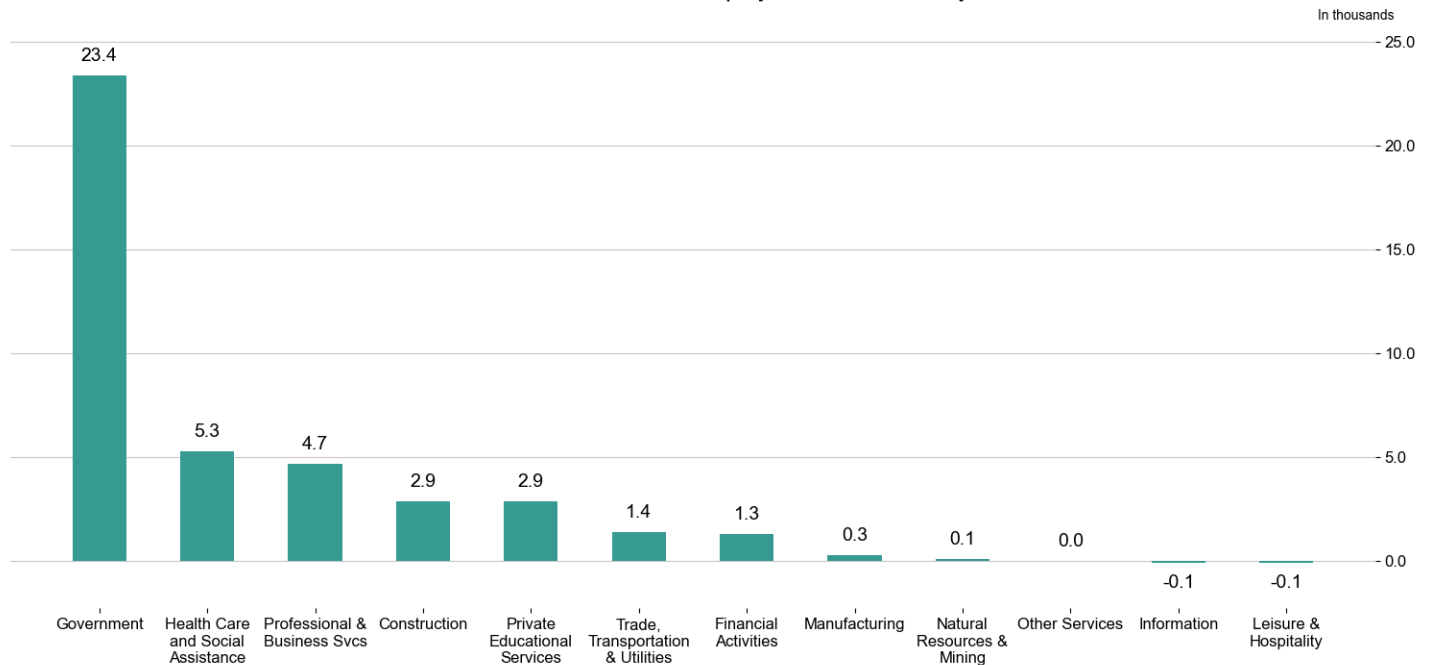

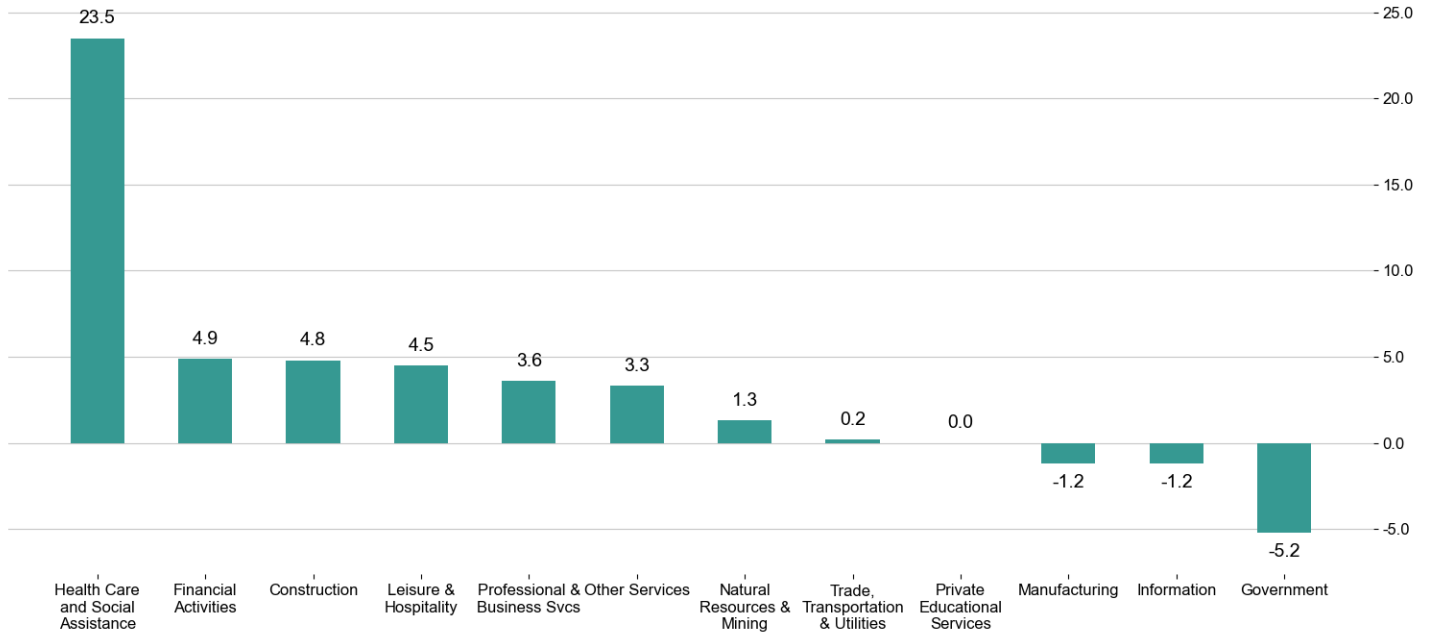

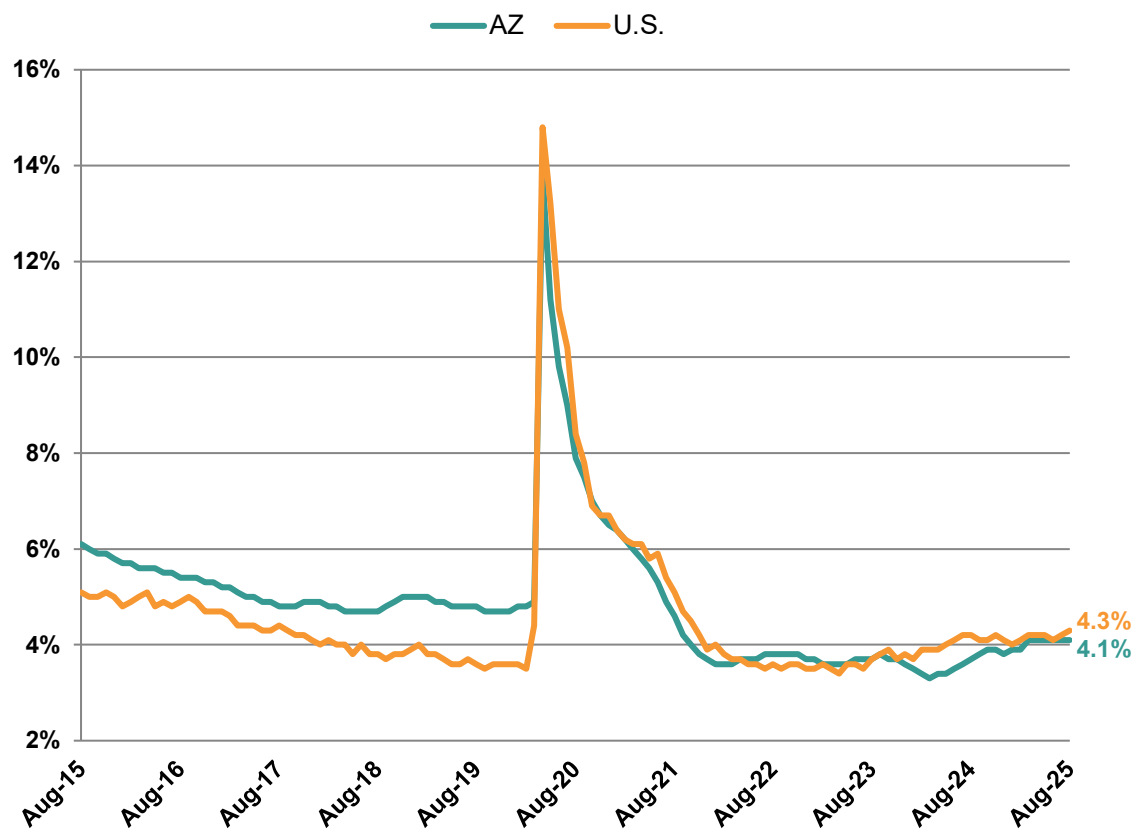

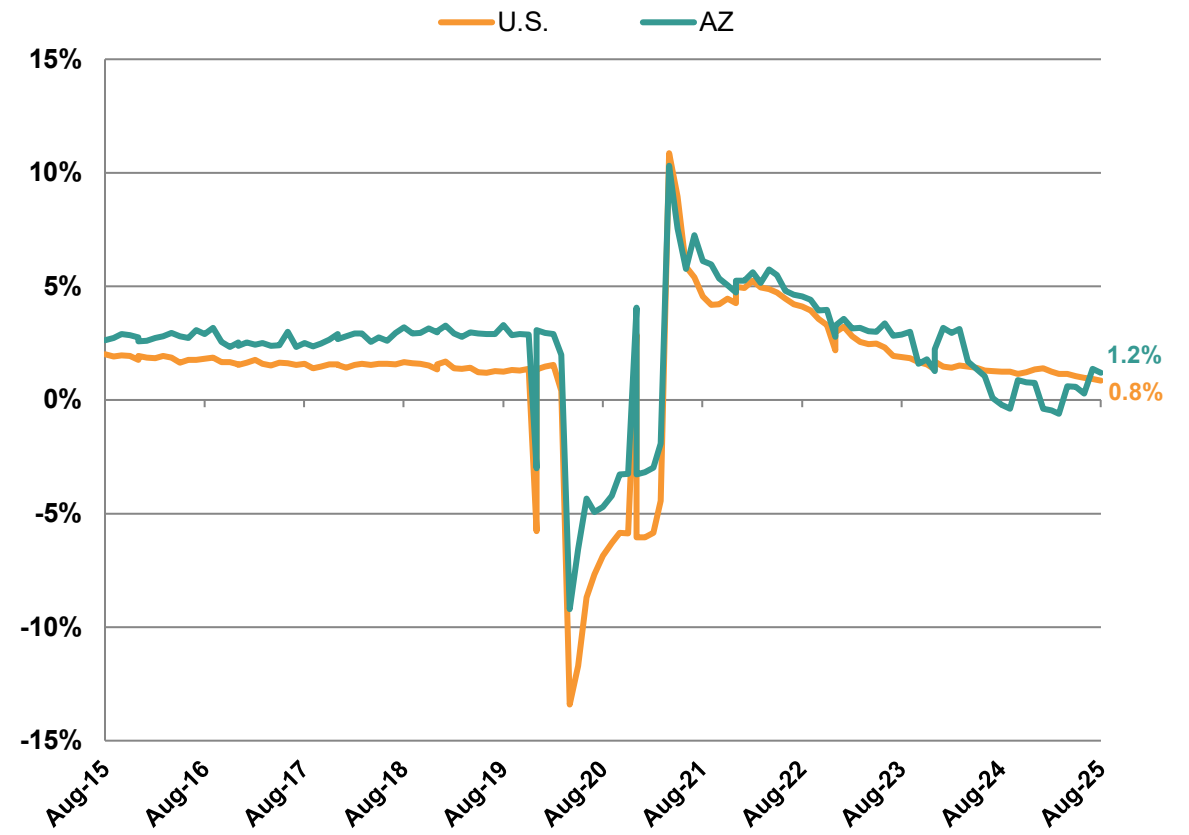
Arizona & U.S. Unemployment Rate

Seasonally Adjusted



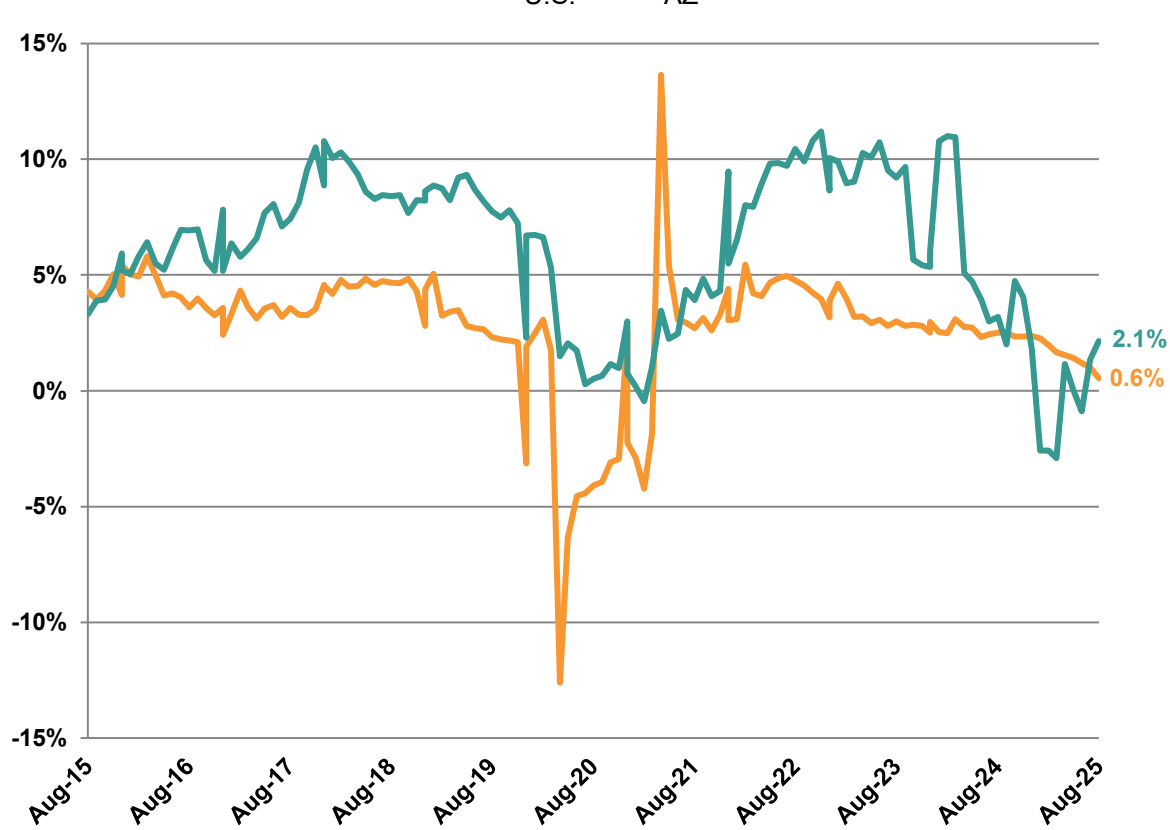
Arizona & U.S. Nonfarm Employment

Year-to-Year Percent Change



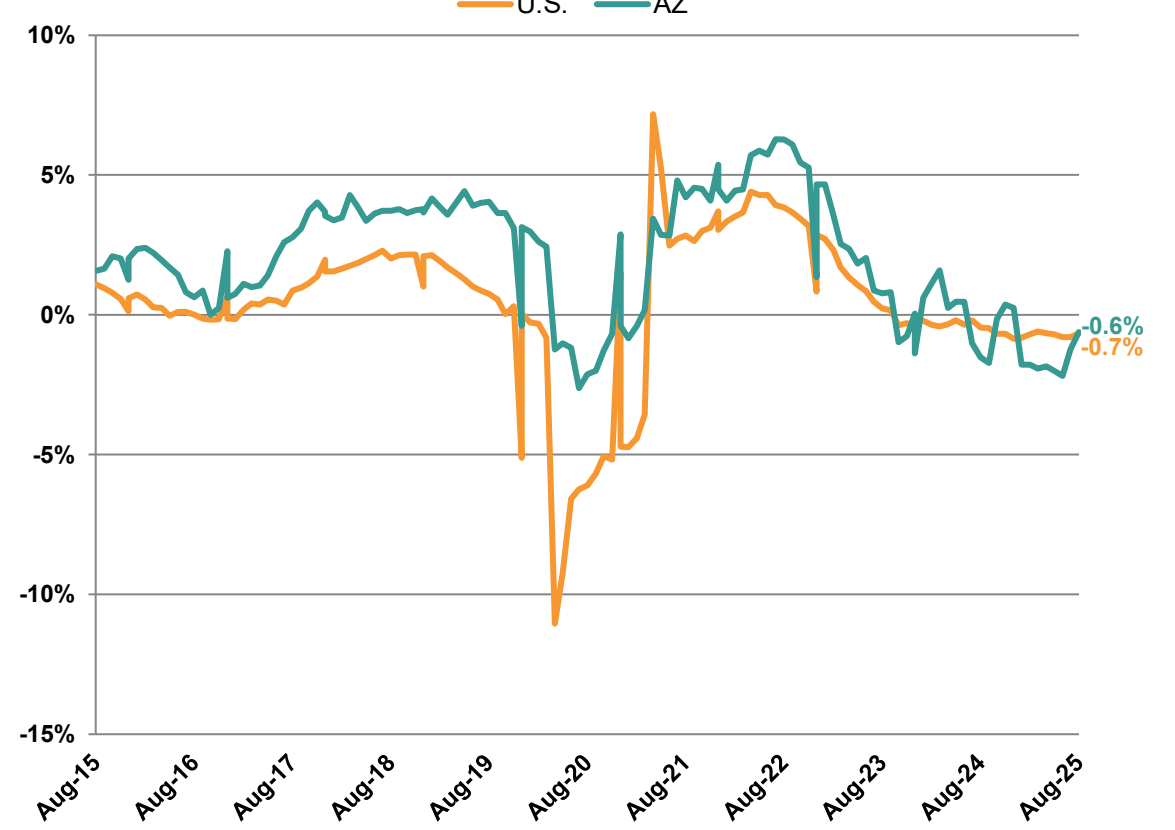
Arizona & U.S. Construction Employment

Arizona & U.S. Manufacturing Employment

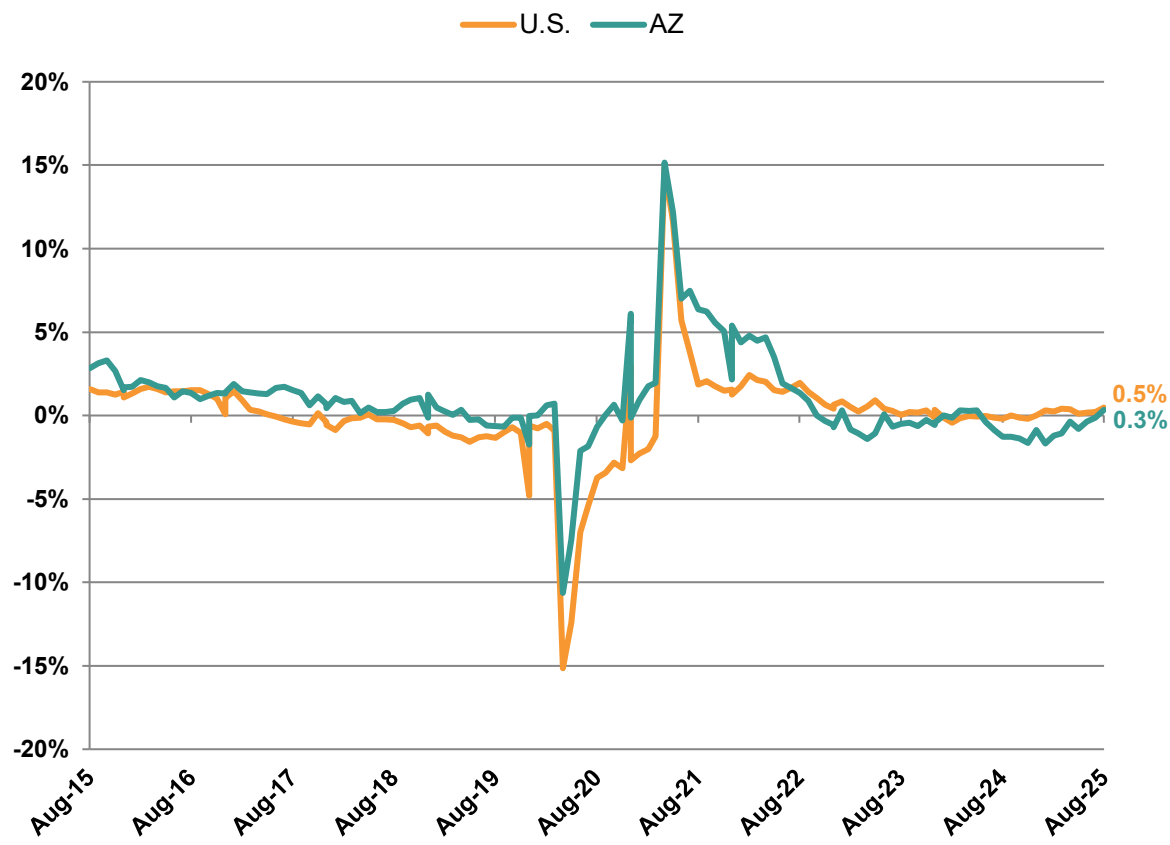

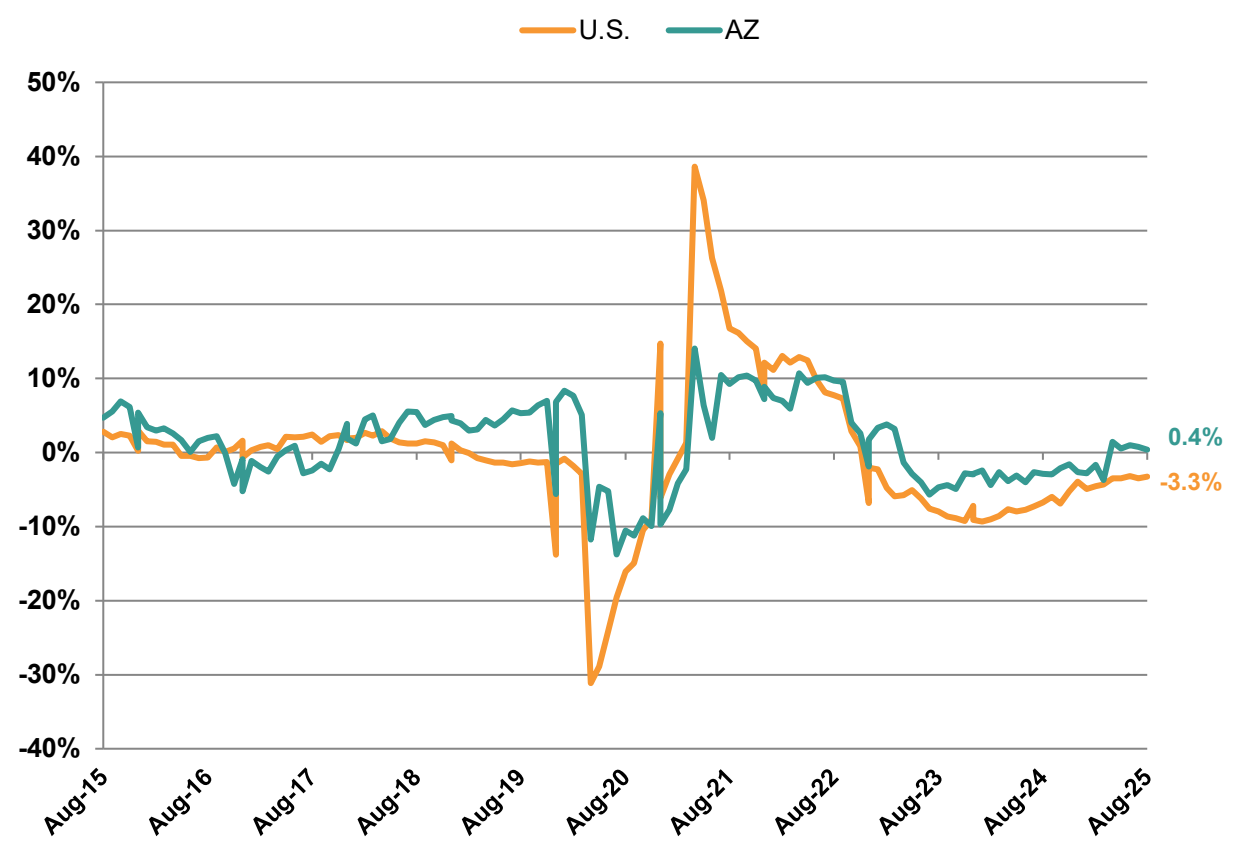

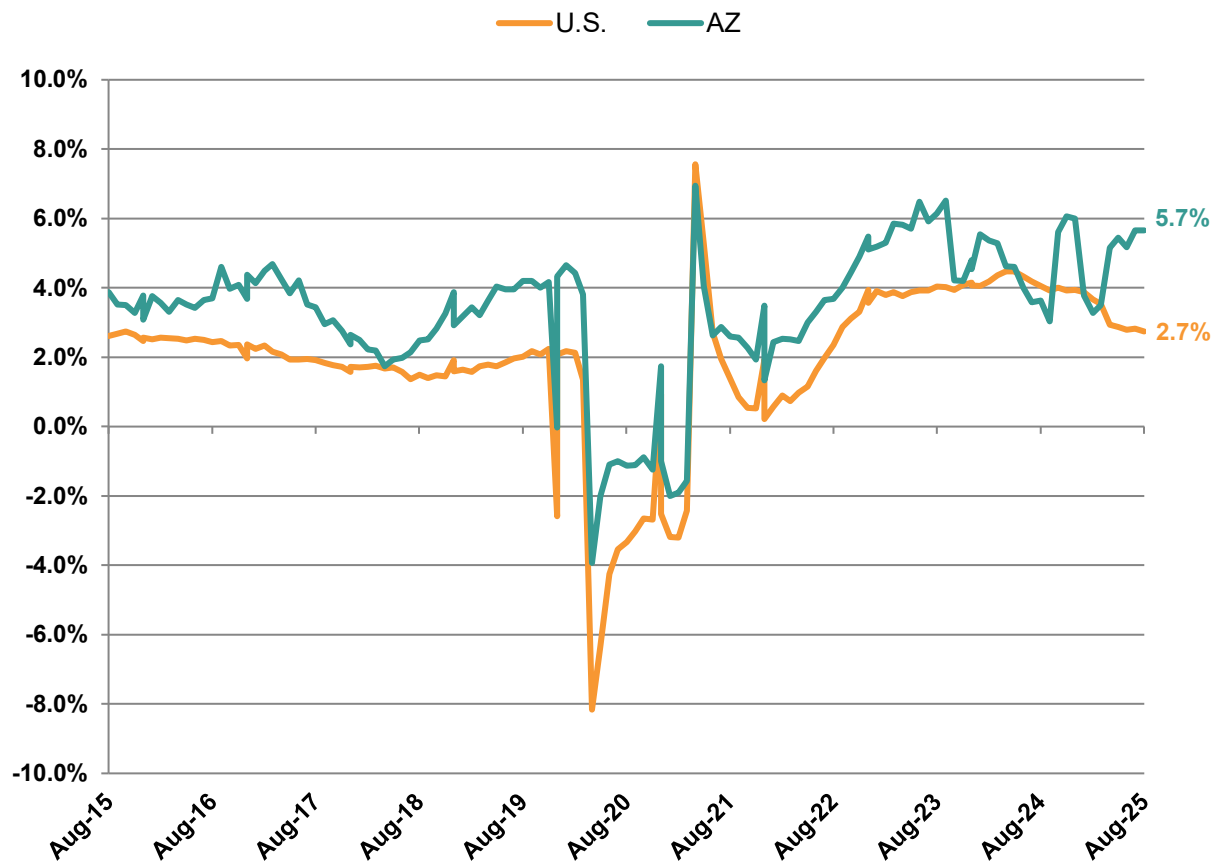
Arizona & U.S. Retail Trade
Year-to-Year Percent Change



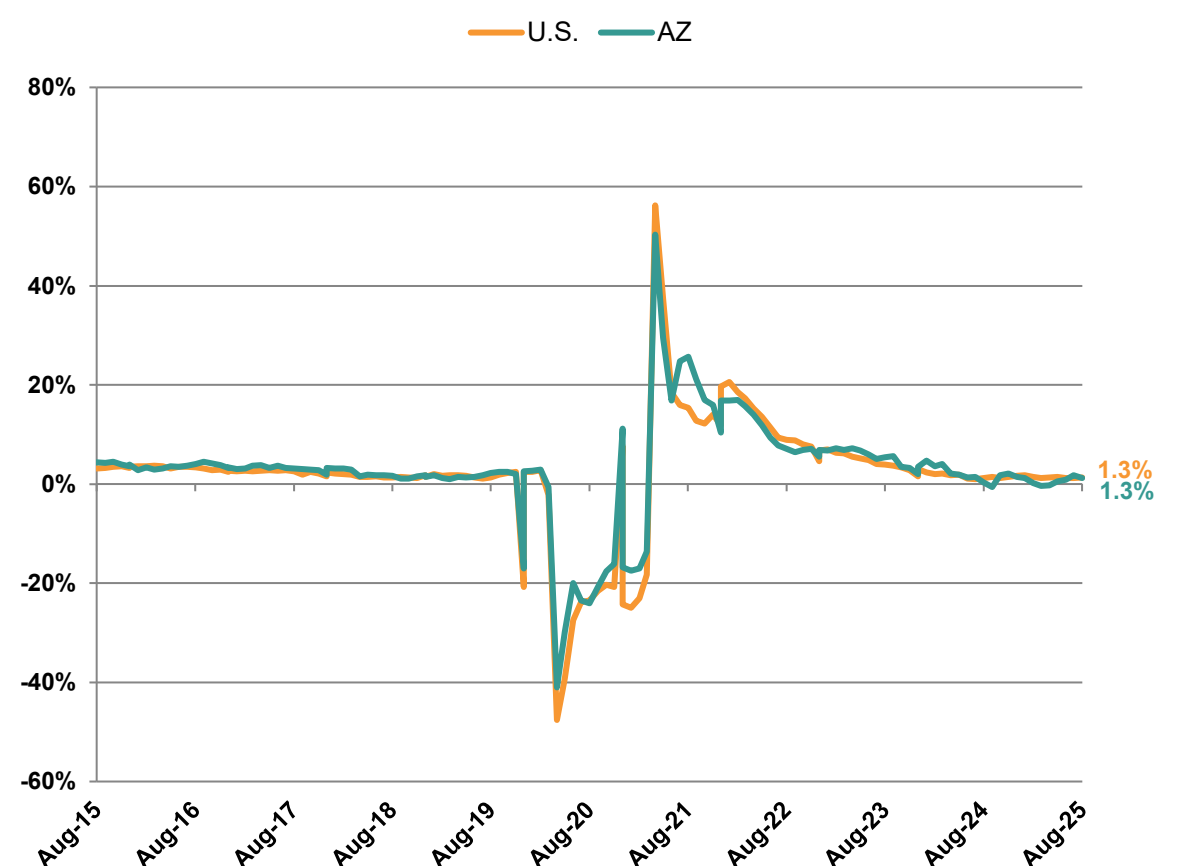
Arizona & U.S. Employment Services
