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Arizona Employment Increased by 24,600 Jobs Since December 2024 Arizona Unemployment Remained at 4.3%

The Arizona seasonally adjusted (SA) unemployment rate remained at 4.3% in December 2025 from November 2025. The U.S. SA unemployment rate decreased to 4.4% in December 2025 from 4.5% in November 2025.

Month over month, Arizona's SA labor force increased by 9,539 individuals, or 0.2%. Year over year, the SA labor force increased by 92,885 individuals, or 2.5%.

Month over month, Arizona not-seasonally adjusted (NSA) total nonfarm employment increased by 6,500 jobs. Year over year, NSA total nonfarm employment increased by 24,600 jobs, or 0.7%. Arizona SA total nonfarm employment increased by 6,400 individuals, or 0.2%, month over month.

Month Over Month

Arizona NSA nonfarm employment increased by 6,500 jobs in December. Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), NSA nonfarm employment gained 5,600 jobs on average in December. The private sector recorded a gain of 13,500 jobs in December, led by gains in Trade, Transportation & Utilities (5,900 jobs) and Health Care and Social Assistance (2,900 jobs). Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), private sector employment averaged a gain of 9,800 jobs in December. The government sector recorded a loss of 7,000 jobs in December, more than the pre-pandemic (2010-2019) average loss of 4,100 jobs. Employment losses in the government sector occurred primarily within State Government (-6,200 jobs).

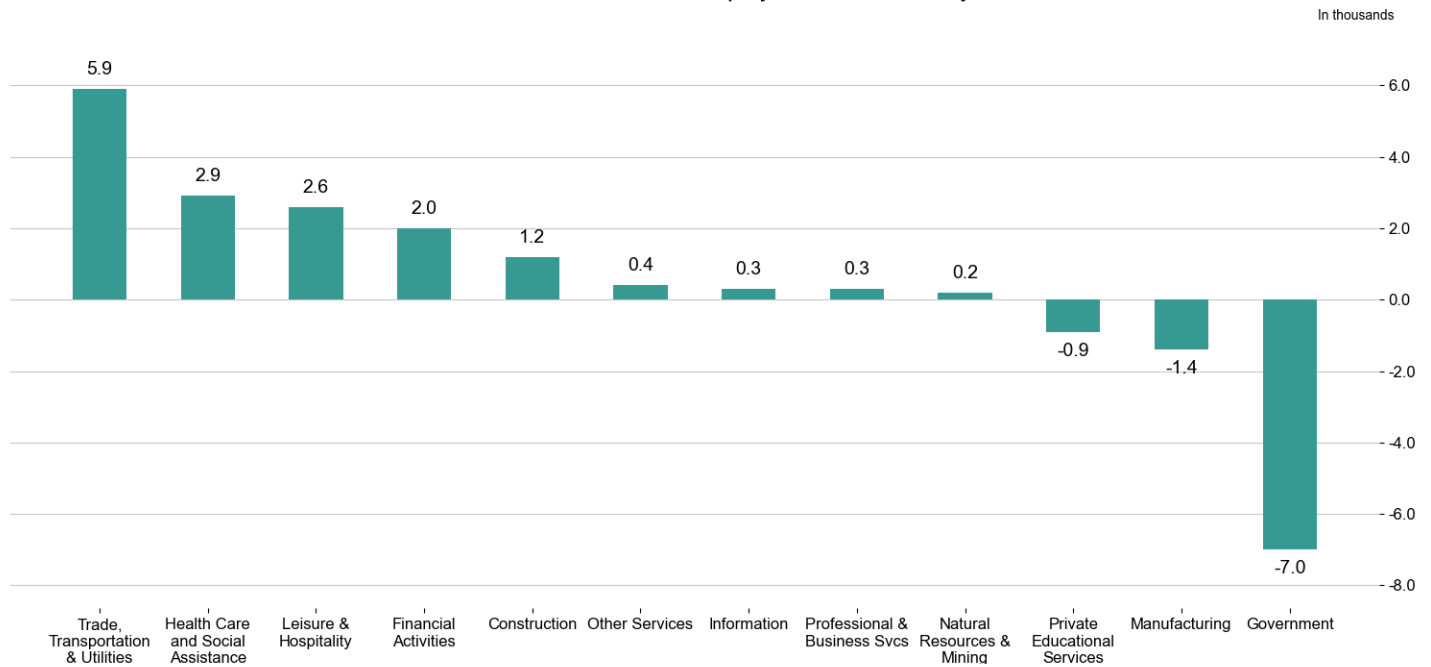

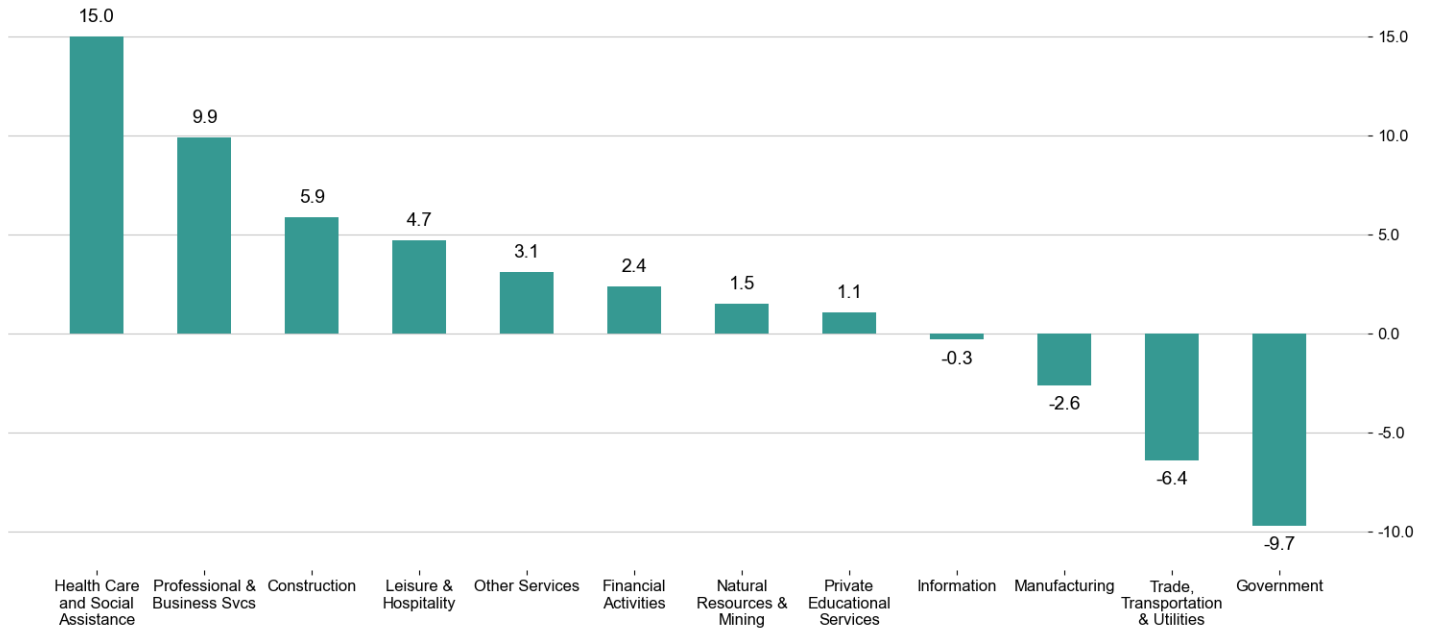

Arizona NSA Year-Over-Year Employment Gain/Loss by Sector

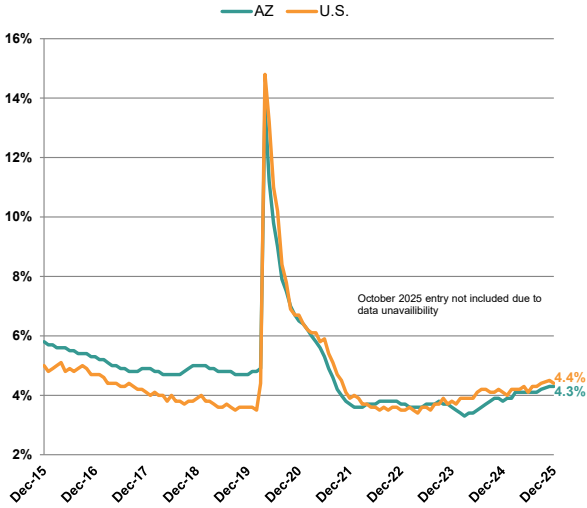

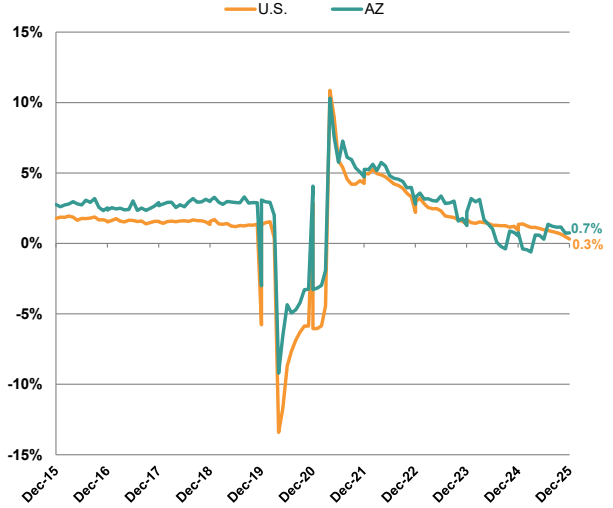

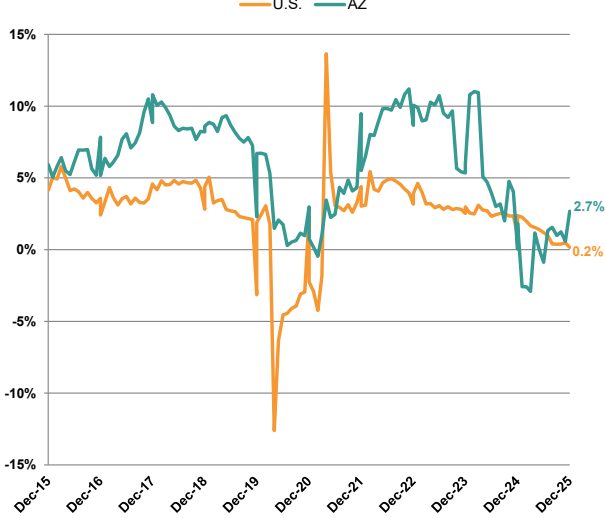
Arizona & U.S. Unemployment Rate
Seasonally Adjusted



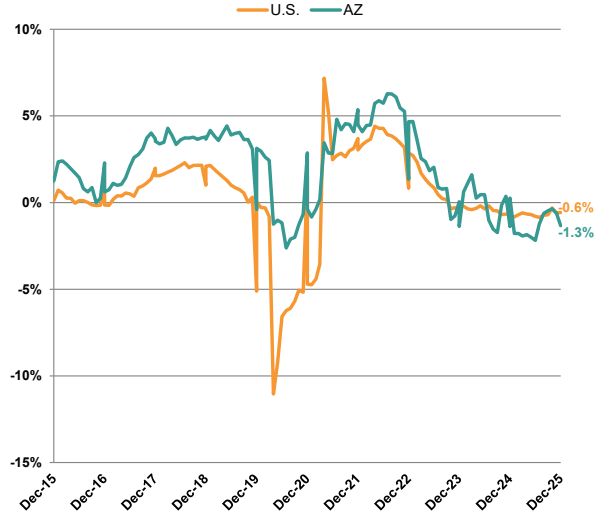
Arizona & U.S. Nonfarm Employment

Year-to-Year Percent Change



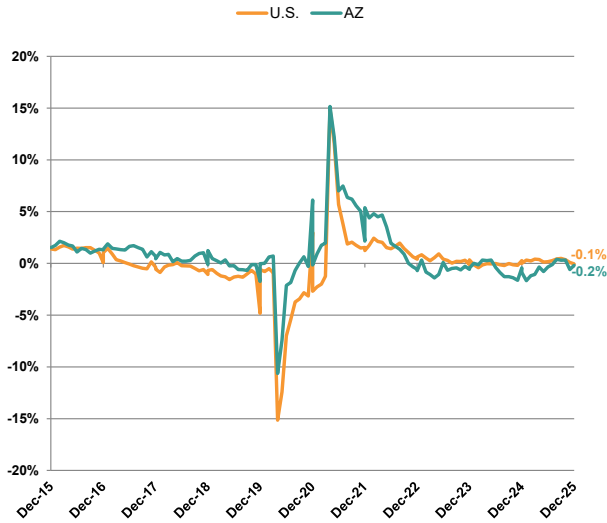
Arizona & U.S. Manufacturing Employment
Year-to-Year Percent Change



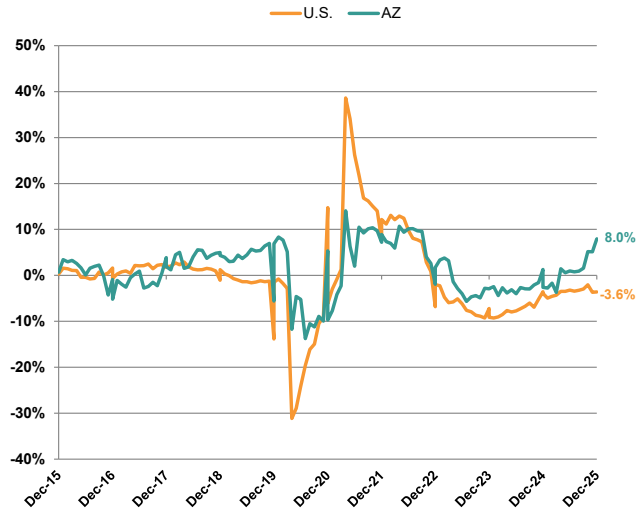

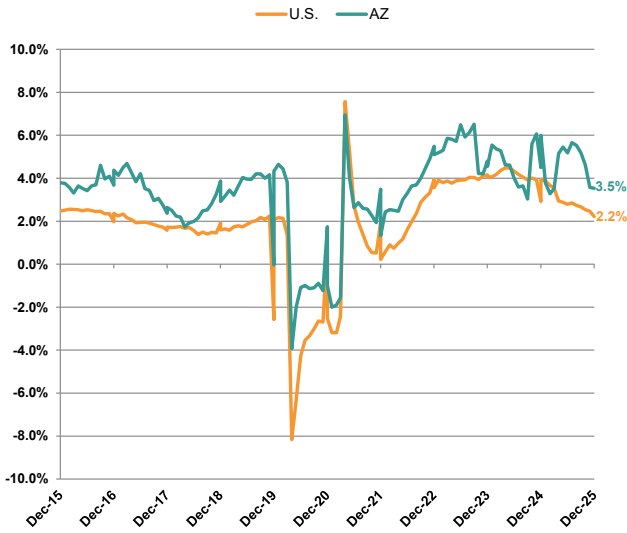
Arizona & U.S. Retail Trade
Year-to-Year Percent Change



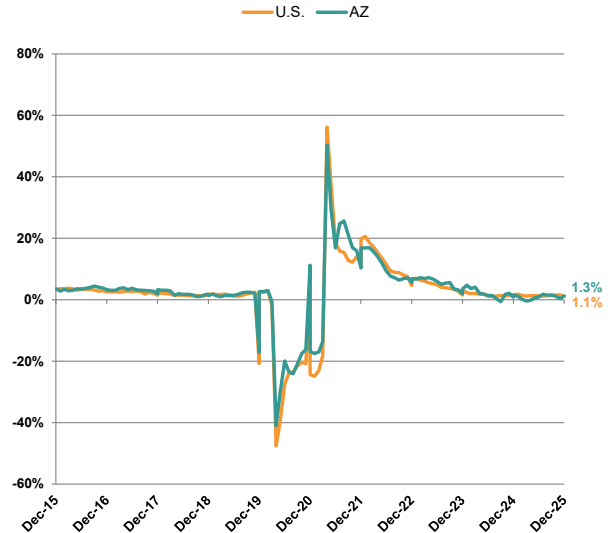
Arizona & U.S. Employment Services
